Subject: English Language and English Literature in Form 4 (2014-2015)

Heads of School are kindly requested to take note of the following:

- Students who are currently in Form 3 Track 3 and who will move to Form 4 Track 3 next scholastic year (2014-2015) are to follow the SEC English Literature syllabus.
- Students currently in Form 3 Track 2 will move to Form 4 Track 3 if they obtain 80-100 marks in this year's Annual Track 2 English examination. These students are to follow the SEC English Literature syllabus.
- Students currently in Form 3 Track 3 will move to Form 4 Track 2 if they obtain 0-49 marks in this year's Annual Track 3 English examination.
- Students in Form 4 Track 1 and Track 2 next scholastic year (2014-2015) are to follow the Alternative English Literature Syllabus, as has been the practice so far.
- As from next scholastic year, Form 4 Track 1 and Track 2 Annual English Examinations will include a Literature component, as is the practice in the Forms 1, 2 and 3 examination papers.

English Language Syllabus Guidelines for Form 4 Students (2014-2015)

Form 4 students will follow the language attainment levels in the English Language Syllabus for Secondary Schools 2007 according to the table below:
