

Dinja Waħda Secondary Programme 2019-2021



Voluntary training for secondary school educators interested in carrying out a Dinja Waħda project

The Dinja Waħda programme in Secondary Schools is an action-based programme based on sustainability education methodology. It **applies subject learning outcomes** in:

- a hands-on approach in real-world situations
- transformational education to generate environmentally-aware attitudes
- critical thinking towards creating environmental solutions

Educators interested in taking part in Dinja Waħda Secondary will be creating projects through their subject or during non-formal activity time. These fall within two categories:

1. Action for Biodiversity
2. Environmental Outreach

Two workshops will be held during the scholastic year.

Workshop 1: An introduction to the two categories of the Dinja Waħda Secondary Programme. Participants will be divided into two working groups with a group leader from BirdLife Malta who will explain the project category and share examples of good practice from other schools. Participants will then discuss ideas for similar projects in their schools. Following a short break, participants will switch groups and proceed on the same pattern.

Workshop 2: A sharing of experiences. Participants will be divided into two groups, each with a group leader from BirdLife Malta who will invite each school to present what they carried out. Participants will explain the project, benefits and challenges they encountered and whether they feel the Dinja Waħda programme aims have been met.
