

Primary Mathematics Guidelines

Scholastic Year 2021 - 2022

In 2020 the Primary Maths Support Team (DLAP – MEDE) has reviewed the [Learning Outcomes Framework](#) and the [Primary Mathematics Syllabus](#). All team members have evaluated each learning outcome in these documents from Years 1 to 6. All learning outcomes were then organised in three main categories as indicated in the table below.

	Learning Outcomes highlighted in blue are to be given priority over all other learning outcomes since these are the basic learning outcomes at that particular level.
	Learning Outcomes highlighted in orange are to be treated as second priority, hence covered once basic learning outcomes have been tackled.
	Learning Outcomes highlighted in green are only to be covered if there is enough time to do so. These outcomes will not be assessed in case of Summative Annual Examinations in 2022.
